- In the Canadian Broadband and Canadian Enhanced Services Rate and Coverage Areas, usage will be charged at a rate of \$0.002/KB or \$2.05/MB. In the Mexican Enhanced Services Rate and Coverage Area,

usage will be charged at a rate of \$0.005/KB or \$5.12/MB. In the Bermuda, China, Dominican Republic, India and Israel Enhanced Services Rate and Coverage Areas, usage will be billed at a rate of \$0.02/KB or \$20.48/MB. You must add I-Dial to your account to roam in many destinations. Only the Canadian Broadband Rate and Coverage area supports EV-DO.
